

## **DROP OFF SAFETY REMINDERS!**

With the combination of time change, colder weather and the rainy season upon us, safe drop off and pick up at JLS are on our minds even more than usual. Most kids ride their bikes or walk to school daily, but when the weather shifts we see an increase in car traffic during drop off and pickup. I would like to remind everyone of some basic safety precautions so that we can minimize dangerous situations and blocking of access to the

Please keep in mind the following safety precautions when dropping off or picking up your child:

school and surrounding neighbors in the event of an emergency.



- DO NOT use your cell phone and avoid other distractions while driving
- Slow down and use extra caution when driving in school zones and along commute routes
- Obey crossing guards and "No Right Turn on Red" signs posted at designated school intersections
- Children should get in or out of the car on the passenger side only
- Follow the directional arrows painted on the ground in the main parking lot
- DO NOT double park or park in staff parking spaces
- Pull as far forward as possible before loading or unloading your children and do NOT pass other vehicles to pull in front of them to pick up your child
- · Once your child is in your car, carefully pull out and around waiting cars to exit the parking lot

#### **COMMUNITY NEWS**

#### Be Safe. Be Seen. Bike lights are required by law for riding after dusk.

With shorter days, students are commuting at dusk or in the dark. Bicycle lights and reflectors are required by law at this time of day. Visibility begins to decline at dusk before the sun is completely down, so bicyclists are required to turn on their lights when light begins to fade. A handlebar headlight makes a bicycle visible to others and illuminates the road so the rider can see. Tail lights and reflectors should be mounted on something stable where they won't be obscured by bags, panniers or other gear on the bike. Lights are vastly superior to reflectors, so a red light on the rear is recommended for maximum visibility.
