

Why Should I Participate in the JLS Science Fair?

Science is a part of our lives in the modern world regardless of what profession or path we choose. Richard Feynman, the physicist, talks about the importance of encouraging children to explore "the pleasure of finding things out", not only a joy in and of itself, but also an important skill which will help them throughout their lives.

The JLS Science Fair aims to:

- Encourage all students to pursue a more active interest in the study of science
- Encourage students to explore their natural curiosity about the world and apply a creative, systematic and scientific approach to solving real world problems
- Develop students' scientific thinking and ability to use scientific process and methodology
- Encourage parents, teachers and the community to get involved and provide support in developing our students' scientific pursuits.

Although the Science Fair is voluntary, JLS has had very active participation from its students in the past. JLS science teachers encourage participation in the fair. Science Fair projects are not typically expensive or elaborate models, but sound explorations of good questions and ideas targeted toward the middle school curriculum. Science teachers can provide excellent advice with respect to selecting and pursuing a Science Fair project. The JLS Science Fair is hosted and organized each year by parent volunteers working with a staff representative.
